In 2002, <u>Samaritan Center</u> held the first Ethics in Business Awards event. Since 2012, this event has been coordinated by **RecognizeGood**.

Nominations are made by community members and then researched and vetted by hand-selected business students at Concordia University Texas during their study of ethical principles. Each finalist is then interviewed in person, and students prepare a rigorous, in-depth review before presenting their findings to an independent selection committee made up of hand-selected Leadership Austin alumni.

All finalists are recognized and award recipients announced at the awards luncheon, attended by hundreds of Texas business leaders and growing in size each year.
