We're pleased to introduce a new awards program at <u>Samaritan Center</u> to honor employees and the community. The program recognizes <u>Hope for Heroes</u> staff, Samaritan Center staff, and members of the community for their work in helping veterans.

The Hope for Heroes Awards have three categories. The **On the Spot Award** is given to any staff person who is doing an outstanding job to help others. The **Honorary Veteran Award** is awarded to any staff person that is nominated by a veteran on the Hope for Heroes team. The Honorary Veteran Award goes to a person that has gone out of their way to help veterans. The **Military Community Impact Award** is given to staff or community member that exemplifies military competency and has gone above and beyond to help veterans.

The On the Spot Award is given monthly, the Honorary Veteran Award is given three times a year, and the Military Community Impact Award is given twice a year. July 16 will be our first ceremony and there will be awards presented in each category.

The award recipients receive a certificate, challenge coin (pictured above), and gift card. The Military Community Impact winner also receives a plaque.
